What is the competition?

What is the prize?

1st Prize:

100% scholarship prize (awarded to 1 student): 100% of the programme fee for English, Science, Maths or Economics course in either July 2018 or August 2018.

2nd Prize:

50% scholarship prize (awarded to 1 student): 50% of the programme fee for English, Science, Maths or Economics course in either July 2018 or August 2018.

Please note that all prizes include the costs ordinarily covered by the advertised program fee. They do not include the cost of flights, private transfers, skills extra, additional tuition, additional trips or medical / travel insurance. Competition Rules and Conditions

- ▣ Entries are only open to students aged 10-17 who have made an enquiry or application for a place at Concord Summer School 2018 (English, Science, Maths and Economics) by 14th January 2018.
- ▣ Students who have previously been in receipt of a scholarship from Concord Summer School are not eligible to win this competition, but are welcome to submit an entry.
- ▣ Entries must be received by email no later than 12pm GMT 14th January 2018.
- ▣ Winning entries must be authentic, produced by the student themselves with no assistance, and meet all of the submission requirements of the competition:
 - Designs can be hand drawn or produced on a computer
 - For all submissions, a declaration form must be signed by both parent / guardian and the student.
- ▣ Responsibility cannot be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
- ▣ Concord Summer School accepts no responsibility for plagiarised work.
- ▣ Winners will be chosen by a panel of Concord Summer School staff. Concord Summer School reserves the right to change this decision if an entry is plagiarised, copied or is deemed unsuitable.
- ▣ All entries and their content belong to Concord Summer School upon submission.
- ▣ Winners agree to the use of his/her name, photograph and winning submission in any publicity material.
 - Any personal data relating to the winner or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party.
