APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply for the Anthony Morris Scholarship for a Sixth Form boarding place at the college, the following are required:

- Apply to the college for a boarding place following the normal admissions process: <u>Click here for Admissions process</u>
- A completed the Anthony Morris Scholarship application form (this document)
- A personal statement describing the applicant's objectives, career/university aspirations, extra-curricular activities and their level of community involvement
- Reference Letter from current school Principal/Head Teacher
- o Evidence of academic potential
- Certified copies of certificates and transcripts
- A recent passport size photograph

Following receipt of the above items, the application will be reviewed by the Board of the Anthony Morris Foundation.

Applicants who make the shortlist will be invited for interview. An interview with a member of the Board will be required and an incountry interview is also likely. This will be followed by an in-country assessment of financial eligibility to ensure the scholarships are awarded to those with most need.

Where possible, completed applications for the Anthony Morris Scholarship should be submitted 14 months prior to the applicants chosen entry date.

It is the applicant's responsibility as a scholar to continue to set an outstanding academic example and to be in sympathy with the ethos of the Concord community.
