## PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES REGARDING CORONAVIRUS COVID-19

### GUIDANCE FOR VISITORS

The coronavirus – COVID-19 – continues to be a significant concern for us all. As the health, safety and well-being of our students, staff and visitors are of the utmost importance, we have restrictions in place for access to and movement around our campus.

These restrictions are temporary, but they are necessary to help us provide as COVID-safe an environment as possible for all members of our community. We will continue to review this guidance on a regular basis and will amend it in line with Government guidance. We will ease the restrictions as soon as it is safe to do so.

We are only allowing visitors to enter our campus in the following circumstances:

- if they are expected because they have an agreed appointment with a specific member of staff, or
- if they are delivering mail or ordered goods/supplies, and
- if they can confirm that they have been in self-isolation for a period of 14 days if they have entered the UK from an overseas country which is on the UK Government's list of countries requiring such quarantine, and
- if they or a member of their household are not showing any symptoms of possible COVID-19 infection (i.e. a high temperature of 37.8°C or above, a new and persistent cough, a change to or loss of their sense of taste or smell).

We apologise if these restrictions cause inconvenience, but they are necessary to protect our community.

Visitors will be asked to confirm compliance with the above on arrival.

In addition, all visitors when on campus are asked to comply with the following:

- use hand sanitising gel on arrival and departure - dispensers are located at the entrance to the Main Hall and in many other locations around the campus,
- avoid shaking hands – instead exchange polite verbal greetings,
- report to Reception on arrival, where visitor badges will be issued,
- provide their name and contact number in case this is needed for test and trace purposes,
- wear a face covering - a mask can be provided at Reception if needed,
- maintain good respiratory and hand hygiene,
- follow signage for one-way systems and generally 'keep left' when moving around the premises,
- maintain social distancing – a minimum of 2m wherever possible, otherwise 1m plus.

Kind attention to observing our health and safety restrictions is very much appreciated.
