PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES REGARDING CORONAVIRUS COVID-19

GUIDANCE FOR VISITORS

The College's priority remains the delivery of face-to-face, high-quality education to our students and to ensure the campus remains 'Covid-safe'. Our aim is for minimal disruption to the education of our students as we continue to manage the impact of COVID-19. The College will adopt the government guidance and the wearing of face masks is now a matter of personal choice for students and staff, although we will continue to ask visitors to wear face masks in busy communal areas and when entering buildings.

The health, safety and well-being of our students, staff and visitors continue to be of the utmost importance and we have restrictions in place for access to and movement around our campus.

These restrictions are necessary to help us provide as COVID-safe an environment as possible for all members of our community. We will continue to review the situation on a regular basis and will adjust measures as risks reduce.

We are only allowing visitors to enter our campus in the following circumstances:

- if they are expected because they have an agreed appointment with a specific member of staff,
- if they have been invited officially to attend an event,
- if they are delivering mail or ordered goods/supplies, and
- if they or a member of their household are not showing any symptoms of possible COVID-19 infection (i.e. a high temperature of 37.8°C or above, a new and persistent cough, a change to or loss of their sense of taste or smell).

We apologise if these restrictions cause inconvenience, but they are necessary to protect our community.

Visitors will be asked to confirm compliance with the above on arrival.

In addition, all visitors when on campus are asked to comply with the following:

- use hand sanitising gel on arrival and departure - dispensers are located at the entrance to the Main Hall and in many other locations around the campus,
- avoid shaking hands – instead exchange polite verbal greetings,
- report to Reception on arrival, where visitor badges will be issued,
- provide their name and contact number,
- maintain good respiratory and hand hygiene,
- generally 'keep left' when moving around the premises.

Visitors must report to Reception on arrival.
