



### Guidance for Visitors to Concord College

The coronavirus – COVID-19 – continues to be a significant concern for us all. As the health, safety and well-being of our students, staff and visitors are of the utmost importance, we will continue to have **temporary** restrictions in place as Concord prepares to reopen to students on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020. This is due to the desire to make the College as Covid-Safe as possible for all members of our community. However, the following detailed guidance on restrictions on visits to our campus will be reviewed fortnightly, or sooner if the situation changes, and we will ease them as soon as it is safe to do so.

Visitors to our campus will only be allowed in the following circumstances:

- If they are expected because they have an agreed appointment with a member of staff, **or**
- If they are delivering mail or ordered goods/supplies, **and**
- If they can confirm they have self-isolated for 14 days since entering the UK from an overseas country which is on the UK Government's list of countries requiring such a quarantine period, **and**
- If they (or a member of their household) are not showing any current symptoms of potential Covid-19 infection (i.e. a high temperature of 37.8 degrees or above; a new and persistent cough; a change in their sense of taste or smell)

We apologise if these temporary restrictions cause inconvenience, but these are necessary to protect our community.

Visitors to our campus are asked to comply with the following:

- Use the hand sanitising dispensers located at the entrance to the main hall building as they arrive and as they leave.
- Avoid shaking hands and use/ accept polite verbal greetings instead. Elbow bumps
- Report to reception upon arrival where they will be issued with a visitor's badge.
- Provide their name and contact number in case this is needed by the NHS for track and trace purposes.
- Visitors are asked to wear a face covering when on campus and inside buildings (-unless they are a member of an exempt group). Spare face coverings can be requested at reception if needed.
- Maintain good respiratory & hand hygiene when on campus.
- Follow the signage for one-way systems and generally "keep left" when moving around the premises.
- Maintain social distancing – ideally of 2m - but at least "1m plus".
